Musings from Maggio

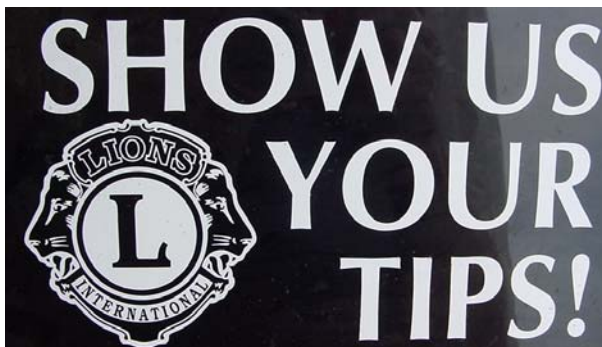
