Lions PLISKY, BEDFORD, MAGGIO & STAY for their support on this project. Here are some points!

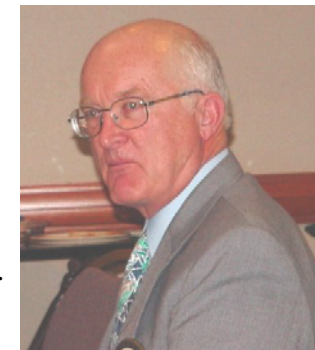
