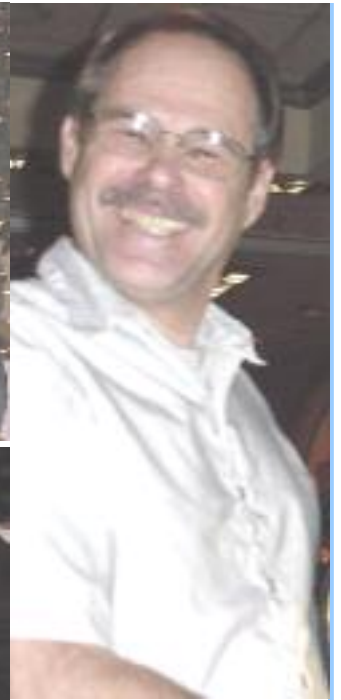
Installation
