pot. If it seems strange to nearly have two double-winners, remember that the odds aren't very long when only a handful of Noontimers attend the meeting.

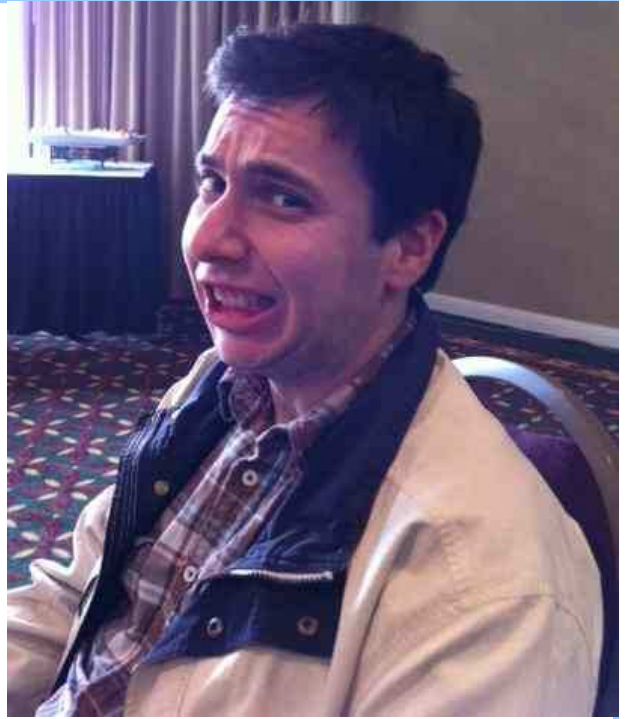
