Lion D Pat RIGGS has Free Fines, while Lion Dave TA-

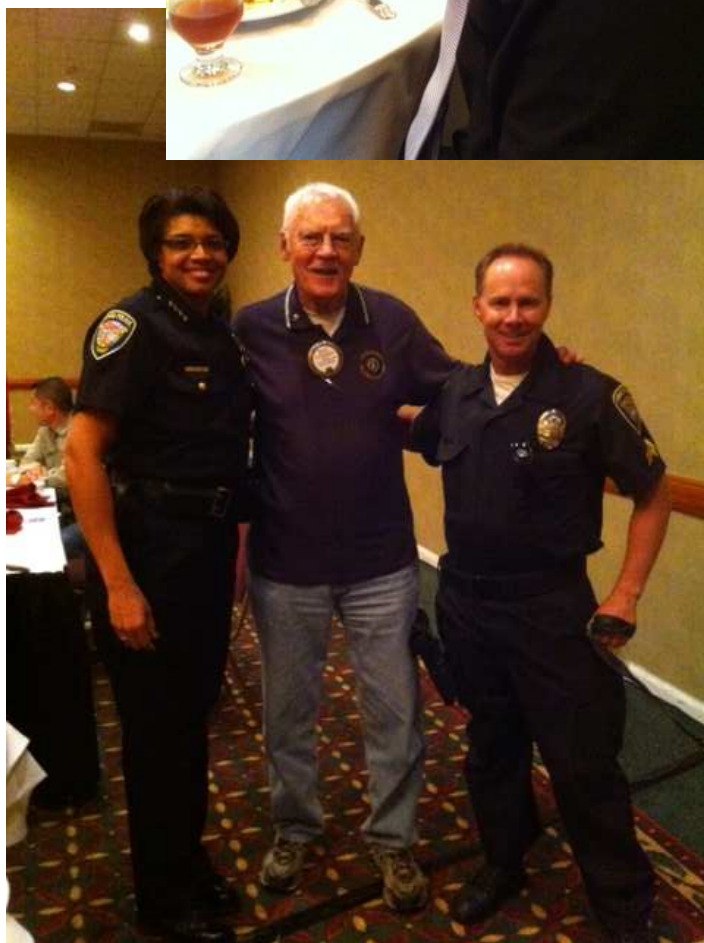
