## Musings from Maggio



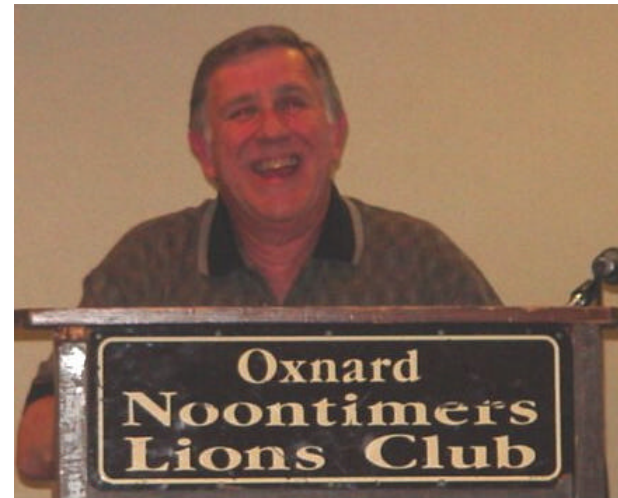
Welcome to Bored Approved new Lion Dennis Amick, sponsored by Lion Todd. Lion Dennis is a
