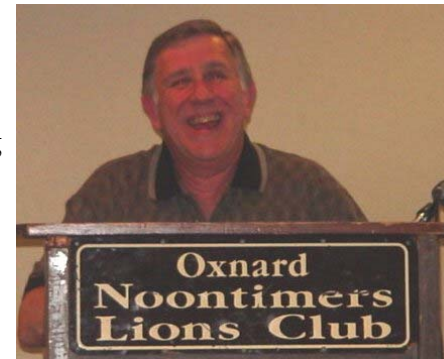
makes it today. In the Mad Marble Malarkey, new Lion Dennis AMICK attempted to grab the \$243.50 prize, but for the second week in a row missed.
