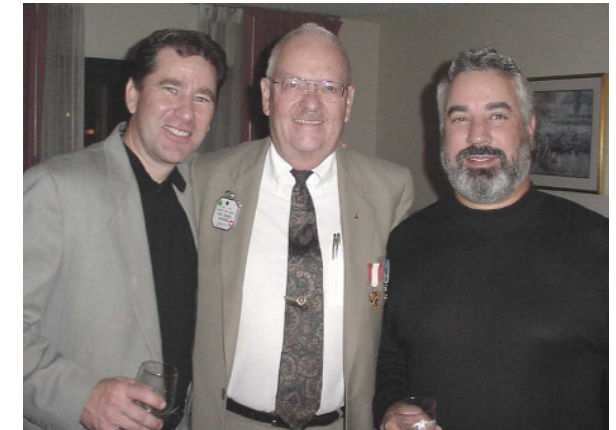

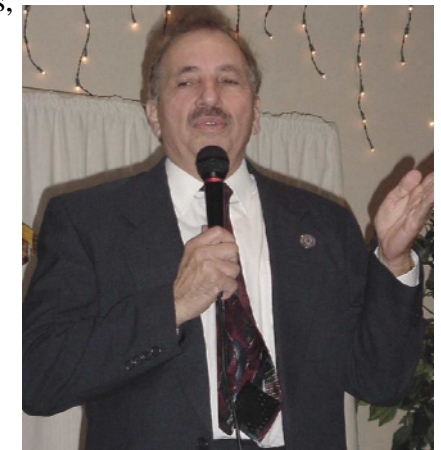


## [Holiday party](#)
