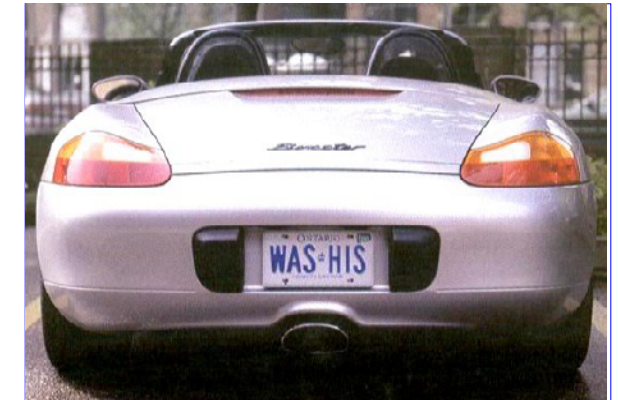
## Winners
