## Last week

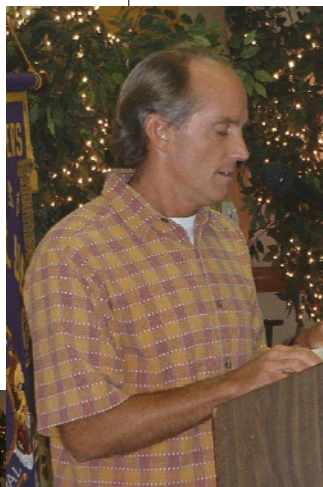
