We will be manning a poll for the Primary Election on June 5. We will need to meet the following requirements:

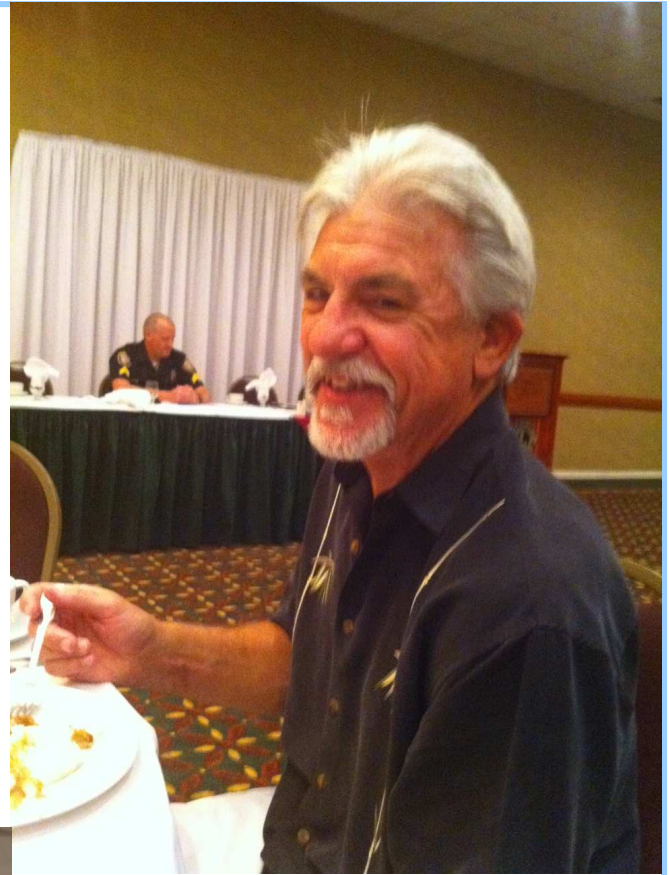
- A) Poll workers must be a registered Ventura County voter

We will probably be assigned to a poll near the coast guard station in CI harbor.

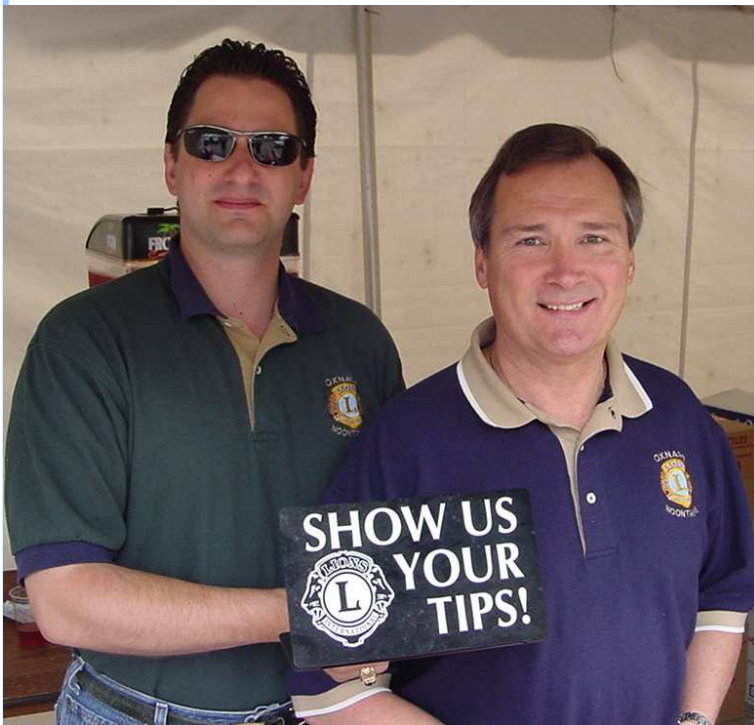
We need to get a sign up sheet sent to the county clerk's office as soon as possible.
