Bored Report

We approved the membership request of new Lion Pat OROSCO.

After some discussion we decided to try to secure the date of Friday, June 8, for an evening Installation event at the Marriott.

We changed the rules for payment for guests: All prospective members will receive up to three free lunches, but the host of guests who are not prospective members will be charged. The host is the determiner of who is a prospective member and who is not. We needed to change because our Admin fund is hemorrhaging money. We are down from about \$11,000 a year ago to only \$4,000 now. We will also have to come up with new activities that raise money for Admin.

We have agreed to host a booth at the Oxnard Harbor's Banana Festival. We will pay a nominal amount for the booth and be required to give away a banana dish. But we will be allowed to sell whatever foot item we want and keep the proceeds.
