that was heard to completion wasn't a joke. It was just a clumsy attempt to extort money from the potential goats. We raised \$142 in fines — mostly not to hear jokes.

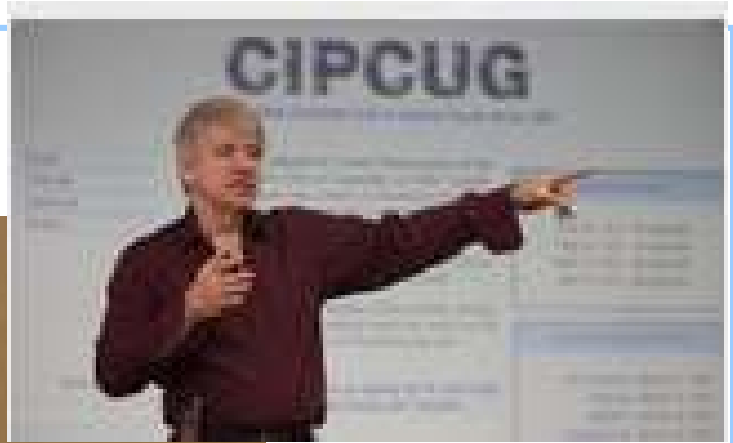
