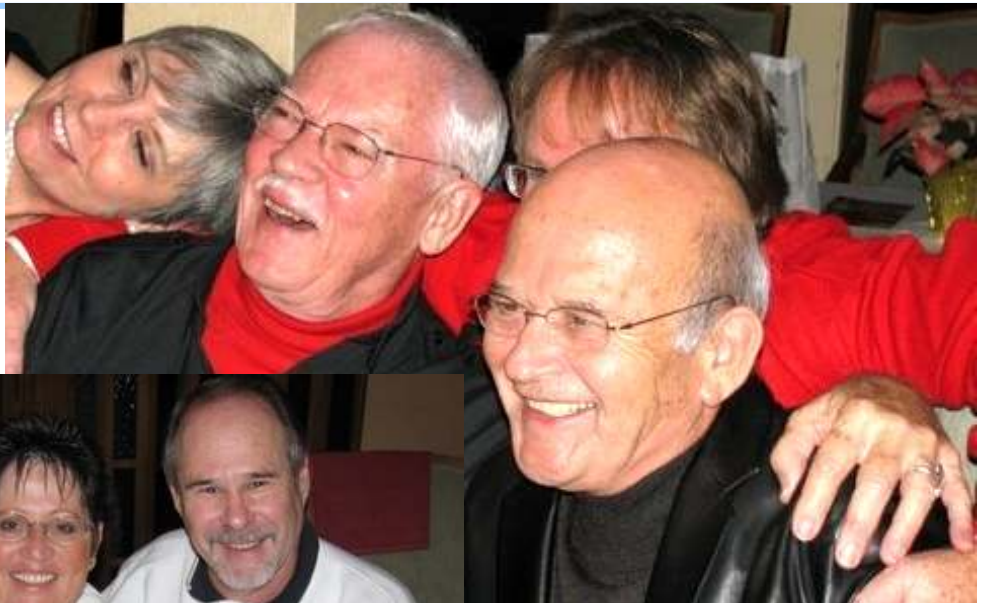
## [Christmas Party](#)
