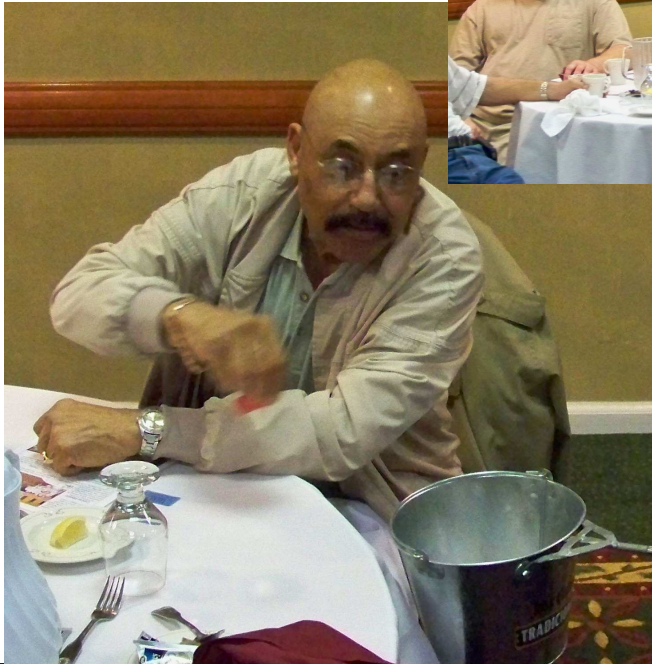
## Cabinet Meeting
