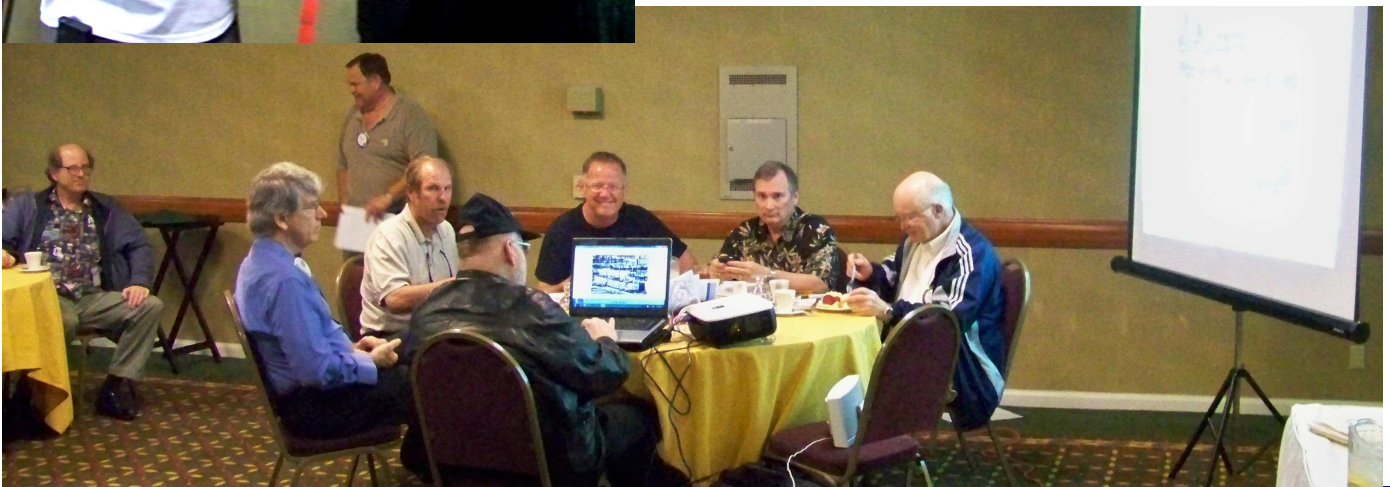


### Casino Night
