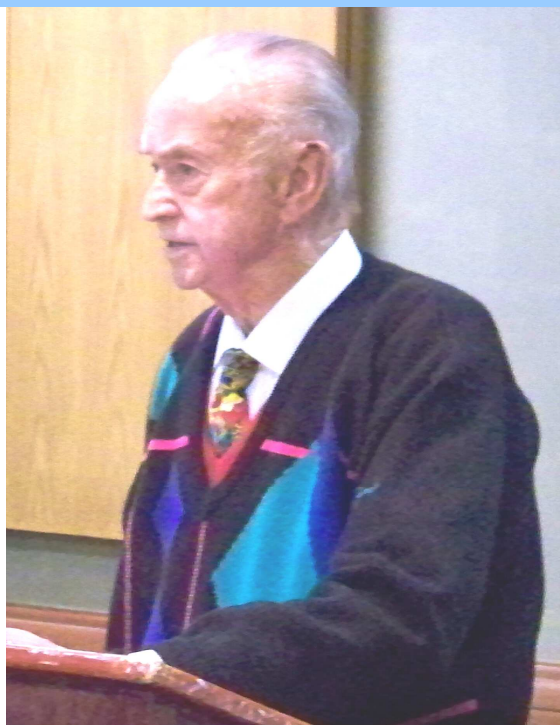
### [This week](#)
