

Health Fair

We have a final count on the Health Fair. We screened 561 patients. Only 61 needed no prescription. We fitted 485 pairs of recycled eye glasses and have 15 pairs being created at the labs because we didn't have a fit. One patient needs cataract surgery on at least one eye, 2 need surgical excision of their pterygi-

um on at least one eye, one needs laser treatment for proliferative diabetic retinopathy, 2 need treatment for glaucoma, one needs treatment for superficial punctate keratitis, one need a follow-up on a retinal hole, another needs follow-up on a pupil anomaly and one more needs LPI for narrow anterior chamber angles. Got that???

It is not possible to describe how much better a service we are providing this year than in years past. Friends in Sight has really stepped up to deal with the hard cases.
